



Waunakee Rotary Foundation 2018 Service to Humanity Scholarship Application

Description

The Waunakee Rotary Foundation awards four \$1,500 Service to Humanity Scholarships annually to graduating high school seniors who provide exemplary volunteer or community service.

Eligibility Requirements

- High school seniors in good standing residing in the Waunakee Community School District graduating from Waunakee High School, Edgewood High School, Madison Country Day School, St. Ambrose Academy, or a homeschool.
- Seniors awarded scholarships must be registered as full time students (12 credit hours minimum) at an accredited university, college, or technical school in the Fall of 2018.
- Children of Waunakee Rotary Members are not eligible due to certain tax regulations.
- Scholarship recipients are required to attend the Waunakee Rotary Club meeting held at Rex's Innkeeper on Thursday, June 7, 2018, from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. You and your parents will be our guests during the lunch meeting and you will briefly address the club.

Application Requirements

1. **Complete the attached Application Form and submit all required documents by April 12, 2018. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**
2. Include one recommendation letter from a volunteer or community service supervisor specific to this scholarship. A college application letter of recommendation will not be accepted as a recommendation letter for this scholarship.
3. On separate single sided sheets of paper provide the following information typed in 12 point font:
 - a. The Rotary International 2017-2018 Presidential theme is *Rotary: Making a Difference*. Write an essay between 500 and 1,500 words describing how and why you are making a difference through your volunteer or community service.
 - b. List up to three extra-curricular school or community activities. Describe how you benefited from these experiences and how this could help you in the future.
 - c. List up to three high school classes. Describe what you learned and how this will help you in college or with your future career.
 - d. Which university, college or technical school are you planning to attend and what is your anticipated area of study, major or career goal?
