Waunakee Rotarians received an update on the committees' work during Club Assembly Nov. 1.

For the fund-raising committee, Phil Willems reported that advertising sales for the Rotary in Lights brochure was going well. He's hoping distribution of the booklet will more than double the amount of visitors to the light display at Village Park this year.

Jim Tubbs of the meetings committee said Rotary has some interesting speakers planned. If you're thinking about bringing a prospective member, next week would be a good one. Dennis Tiziani, the father-in-law of golfer Steve Stricker, will speak. On Dec. 13, the club will hear from Village Administrator Kim Wilde about the progress in finding a site for the expanded Waunakee Public Library.

Roberta Baumann from the membership committee reported that the club now has 90 members and received Dick Pilsner's resignation. Club President Lynne Spielman added that the club members do a good job bringing new prospective members.

Ed Niebuhr from the fellowship committee reminded club members that the Thanksgiving breakfast is Nov. 22. Volunteers for that event should be there at 7 a.m. Ed and Rich Murphy will be there the day before to prepare.

Tom Reis of the community service committee said a project is planned for another Rotary Park at the retention pond near the Village Center, formerly known as the "stink pond" back in the Stokely Canning factory days. The idea is to build a path around the pond, plant wildflowers and build a bridge to allow for a walking tour of the lights. Also, the pond could be used for ice skating, Tom said. Volunteers will be

putting up the displays at Village Park for the Rotary in Lights event Nov. 10 beginning at 8 a.m.

Lori Derauf from the Interact and Student Exchange committee noted that the next youth Interact meeting will be Nov. 16. She said the Rotary exchange student, Raissa Souza, is doing well. But Rotarians are urged to volunteer for the exchange committee. Lori currently serves as the Rotary Youth Exchange Officer and Greg Garton is the Rotary Youth Exchange Counselor. Next year, Greg will step into the officer role, and someone is needed to fill his role as counselor. Lori said the work is fun but there is a lot of it. This is Rotary's first exchange, so Lori and Greg were the first committee members serving in these roles, and they are working on a manual to make it easier for their successors. Lynne said the paperwork for these students has increased since 9/11.

For the international committee, Bill Erickson reported that Haiti was left unscathed by the hurricanes. A group is leaving Nov. 29 to build a house there. That committee is open to new projects, so let the members know if you have ideas.

Other items:

- Harriet Statz told the club that the Rotary Rustic Road Rally to Galena, Ill. was fun and shared photographs with the club.

- Bill Erickson said the Sun Prairie Rotary Club donated a check for \$500 to pass on to the Safe Water program in Haiti.

- Lynne said the board agreed to contribute \$500 to the Project Linus program that provides quilts for hospitalized children. Last year, Project Linus members sewed 143 quilts. The board also matched \$500 to the \$545 contributed by the club members for the Combat Blindness program. The
